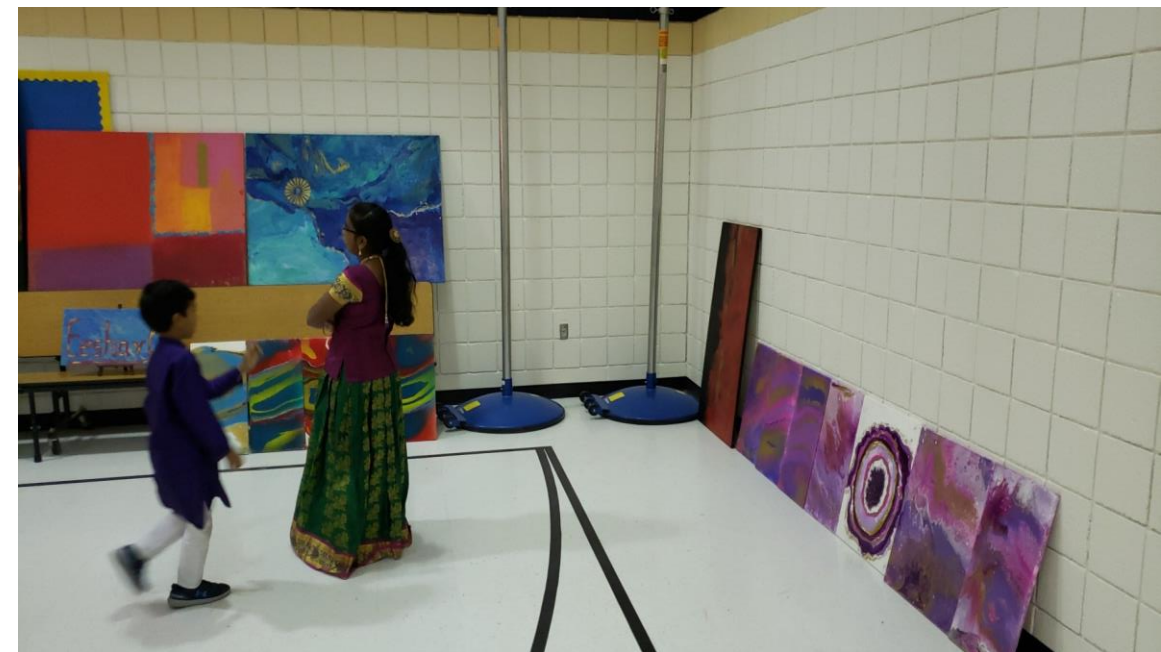
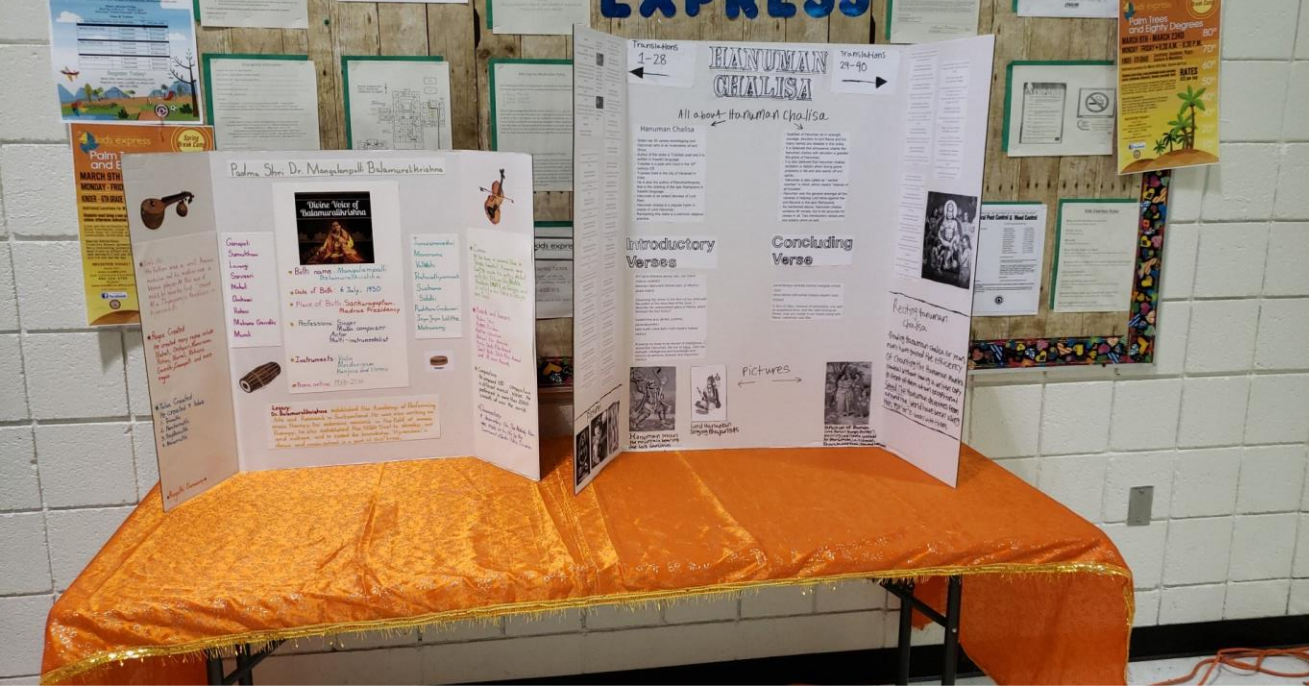

Navayuga 2020 - new-age multi-cultural and arts festival, is the manifestation of this fairly ambitious mission organized on **March 7** at the **Basha Elementary School**, Chandler. It is a first of its kind event that brought together eminent musicians from India and around the US, local valley schools, and various independent artists from a variety of disciplines of art. From Bollywood, Bharatanatyam, Carnatic, Hindustani to Western, this event had it all. With representation from various classical and non-classical forms of music, dance and art from around the world, it was truly a unified global platform for a variety of art forms. The heart behind this mission was to raise funds in support of differently abled and autistic children. The Chief Guest **Mayor Kevin Hartke** graced the event and affirmed his support for the citizens of Chandler. The president of the Indian Association **Venkat Kommineni** emphasized his support to the community. **Jegadeesan Krishnamurthy**, joined the guests of honor and spoke at the event.

The day started with a magnificent concert strings Orchestra performance by the Talented Studios group led by Ms Ellie. This was followed by a splendid Bharatanatyam recital by the students of Shylpa Ganesan and students of **Divya Prabhakar**. Two Bollywood dancing teams - **Desert Dancers** led by choreographers **Arthy Thiru** and **Ritu Srivastava** and **Dancing Stars** led by choreographer **Varsha Shaam** stole the audiences' hearts with their dances and had their feet tapping with their energizing and peppy Bollywood numbers. Adding to the variety was the spell binding Hindustani Classical recital by the duo **Nisha Kulkarni** and **Aditi Tata**, students of **Phoenix Gharana**. The audience were spell bound by the performance of the special child **Shriya Senthil**. The Carnatic vocal duet by **Krupalakshmi** and **Bhargav Hartharan**, who travelled all the way from Philadelphia to be a part of Navayuga 2020 was exhilarating and held the room in a trance. They were accompanied on the mridangam by **Shiva Sunder**. **Navaneeth Vadakkan** took the room by storm with his splendid rendition of a



few cherry-picked movie songs in various South Indian languages. The **Rockarnatic** performance by the duo **Atul Raman** on mridangam and **Rithvik Jandhyala** on guitar was enthralling and unique. Budding Carnatic vocal talent **Manasa Subramanian**, disciple of **K N Shashikiran** and daughter of Usha Ramachandran, accompanied by Atul Raman on the mridangam captured the audiences' attention with her stunning recital. The presentation of the **Mahishasura Mardini Stotram** by a group of students trained by Usha Ramachandran was powerful and impressive. The mridangam performance by the students of **Sri Mahesh Subramaniam** was thrilling and had our hearts beating to the rhythm of the mridangams. The highlight of the day was the 2 hours Carnatic vocal duo concert by the reputed Carnatic Brothers, world record holders - **K N Shashikiran** and **Chitraveena P Ganesh**, accompanied by M.A.Sundareswaran on the violin and **KV Prasad** on the mridangam. All celebrity musicians visiting from India were sensational and left the audience wanting more. The **Carnatic Symphony** by the students of Usha Ramachandran was awe-inspiring and superbly crafted. The day concluded with the performance of music and dance from around the world by the students of **Kari Weldon**. Students of Usha also displayed project presentations on topics such as **Dr. Balamuralikrishna**, **Hanuman Chalisa**, and soon.



Mayor Kevin Hartke honored many valley gurus with a memento for their contribution in the field of art. All the performers were awarded a medal and a certificate by the Mayor.

Navayuga 2020 had various women entrepreneurs come together and set up art, face painting and food stalls to help raise funds for the good cause. Any great event is backed by generous sponsors and a group of hardworking volunteers. Usha Ramachandran's competent co-ordination and months of hard work was evident in the splendor of the event. 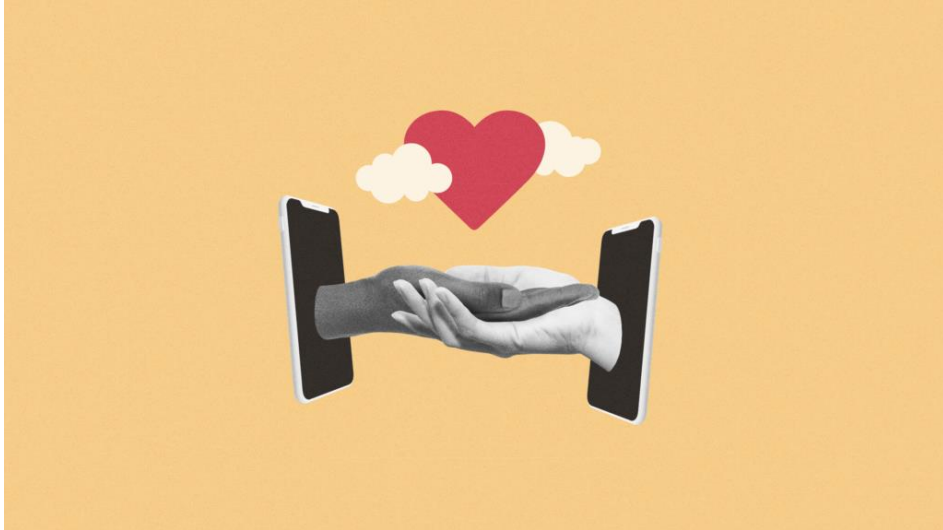
