Dates of Employment: June 29 - July 24, 2026 (for musical theatre),

June 29- August 7 for other Programs

Note:

- These dates / weeks include the program dates. In addition, musical theatre leads may be required to help in planning outside of instruction hours, equipment set-up, repair, and program closing.

Objective:

- To plan and lead the day-to-day operation of the Musical Theatre Program, Toddler Night, Dance, and the Arts Program

Responsibilities:

- Collaborate with the Supervisors and instructors to write the script prior to programming starting (must be submitted to the director by a mutually agreed upon date before the end of June)
- Choreograph dance routines
- Organize drama games and skills building workshops
- Develop and deliver programming for the musical theatre program
- Communicate with families
- Coordinate volunteers
- Support the supervisor in duties such as tracking attendance of volunteers, employees, and attendees
- Set up for all events
- Organize crafts- set up and clean up

Qualifications/ Prerequisites:

- Min.15 years old
- 2 years volunteering or equivalent
- Standard First Aid and CPR Level C
- Musical Theatre, drama, writing, art, and dance experience needed
- Leadership experience
- Experience working with children
- Driver's License is an asset
