The parish office is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 6:00 PM.

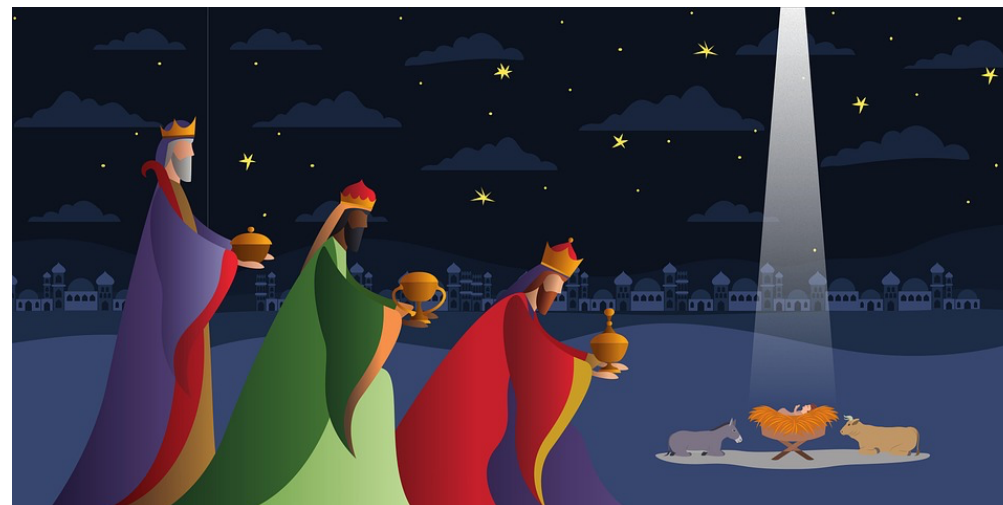

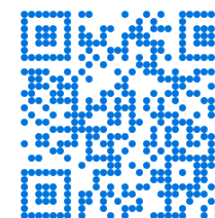
