Pastor's Letter
Fr. Gerald E. Murray

Dear Parishioners,

Our prayers continue for Pope Francis. Last Sunday he sent this message from the hospital: “Sisters and brothers, I am still sending you these thoughts from the hospital, where, as you know, I have been for several days, accompanied by doctors and healthcare professionals, whom I thank for the attention with which they are taking care of me. I feel in my heart the “blessing” that is hidden within frailty, because it is precisely in these moments that we learn even more to trust in the Lord; at the same time, I thank God for giving me the opportunity to share in body and spirit the condition of so many sick and suffering people.

“I would like to thank you for the prayers, which rise up to the Lord from the hearts of so many faithful from many parts of the world: I feel all your affection and closeness and, at this particular time, I feel as if I am “carried” and supported by all God’s people. Thank you all! I pray for you too. And I pray above all for peace. From here, war appears even more absurd. Let us pray for tormented Ukraine, Palestine, Israel, Lebanon, Myanmar, Sudan and Kivu. Let us entrust ourselves confidently to Mary, our Mother. Happy Sunday, and *arrivederci*.”

The Stations of the Cross will be prayed this coming Friday, and all the remaining Fridays of Lent, at 6 PM in the church. All are invited to join.

The Novena to St. Joseph, our parish patron saint, will be begin on Tuesday, March 11th. The Novena Prayers will be recited immediately following the 12:15 PM daily Mass and the 12 PM Sunday Mass. Novena donation envelopes are available on the tables at the back of the church. The envelopes will be placed on the altar during the nine days of the novena. You may drop off your envelopes at the parish office or give them directly to one of the priests.
