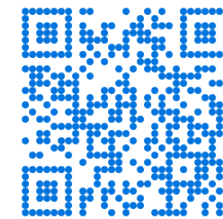

The Blessing of Throats will take place on Tuesday February 3rd, the Feast of St. Blaise, after the 7 AM and 12:15 PM Masses.

On Friday February 6th, the First Friday of the month, Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament will take place after the 12:15 Mass, concluding with Benediction at 1:45 PM.

On Friday February 6th the Prayer Group for Fathers will meet in the church at 8:10 AM. The 15-minute meeting will include a short homily and prayers.
