Dear Parishioners,

Good news: We have surpassed our Cardinal's Appeal 2026 goal!

As of April 14th, 66 donors have donated or pledged a total of \$110,330. Our parish will now receive a 60% rebate from the Archdiocese of New York of all the money donated above our goal. From Pope Leo's April 14th Homily in ancient Hippo, Algeria:

“Dearest Christians of Algeria, you remain a humble and faithful sign of Christ's love in this land. Here the martyrs prayed; here Saint Augustine loved his flock, fervently seeking the truth and serving Christ with ardent faith. Be heirs to this tradition, bearing witness through fraternal charity to the freedom of those born from above as a hope of salvation for the world.”
