Dear Parishioners,

On December 1, 1984 Archbishop John J. O'Connor ordained me to the Holy Priesthood at St. Patrick's Cathedral. Today is my 40th anniversary as a priest of Jesus Christ. I am very grateful to God for the 40 years I have been blessed to serve Him and his Church as a priest. I ask him to give me many more years as his servant in the vineyard of the Lord.

Being a priest is a great gift from God. Priests preach the Gospel and administer the sacraments. Priests serve as shepherds of souls amidst the sheep of Christ's flock. I pray that more young men will hear and answer the call to serve as priests here in the Archdiocese of New York. My ordination class consisted of 19 men.
