Dear Parishioners,

Today we begin Holy Week. A flyer with the complete Holy Week Schedule is available on the table at the back of the church. **Please note that the Holy Thursday Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper will be celebrated at 6 PM this year, and adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament in the Repository after Mass will conclude at 9 PM. There is no Mass at 7 AM or 12:15 PM on Holy Thursday. Please also note that on Good Friday the Stations of the Cross will be prayed at 12 Noon in English and at 6 PM in Hungarian. The Good Friday Liturgy will be celebrated at 3 PM.**

**Monday April 14<sup>th</sup> is Reconciliation Monday. Confessions will be heard here at St. Joseph's, and at all the parishes in the Archdiocese of New York and the Dioceses of Brooklyn and Rockville Centre, from 2-4 PM and 6-9 PM.** Confessions will also be heard on Wednesday April 16<sup>th</sup> from 4-5:45 PM, on Good Friday from 10 AM-12PM, and on Holy Saturday from 4-5 PM. Please take advantage of these extended times to make a good confession before Easter.
