The Tama County Board of Supervisors has passed **Resolution 3-3-2025C**, implementing a **\$50 permit fee per residential property** for dust control applications.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By applying for the Dust Control service, the applicant agrees to adhere to the following terms and conditions set forth by the county and the CIDC:

1-Application Deadline: All applications must be submitted by April 15th 2025, to ensure the county has adequate time for road preparation before the first application. Late submissions will be scheduled for the second round of service without exceptions.

-Per Tama County, late customers can be added on for a \$25.00 fee (each add-on) within two week grace period of application date.

-Additional requests received any time outside of the two-week grace period may be approved on a case-by-case basis. The request must be approved by Tama County, and may be denied depending on projects, staffing, etc. Each request will incur a \$100.00 fee which will be paid to the county.

2-Flagging Responsibilities: Applicants are responsible for maintaining red flags at with correct distance throughout the season. Flags, available at the County Engineer's office or maintenance sheds, must be always visible to avoid grading. If grass has grown around flags and cannot be see, engineer has right to blade. It also affects the point where spraying starts and stops. If CIDC cannot see flags when spraying, we'll determine the start of spraying the applicable feet and will not respray additional areas.

3-Measurement and Adjustment: The applicant is responsible for accurately measuring the application area. CIDC reserves the right to remeasure and adjust the treatment area as necessary. Trucks equipped with computerized measuring equipment will verify distances; inaccurately placed flags may affect the measured distance.

4-Product Efficacy: The dust control product is designed for effective dust suppression. However, CIDC does not guarantee performance due to varying factors such as weather conditions, surface preparation, heavy traffic, or county blading activities.

5-Service Agreement: This agreement covers two applications of product, with application dates depending on county scheduling. Initial application is expected in late May/early June, followed by a second application at the end of July/early August.

6- If an agreement is reached with a third party for payment during the season, you are responsible for paying this contract and collecting reimbursement from the third party to cover the cost of the service.

7- Tama County allows the placement of dust control on rock roads. The interest of motorists to have a well-maintained road takes priority over the interest to suppress dust. Dust control sections may be bladed through starting October 15th and may be bladed through at any time if the condition of the road impedes traffic. Preserve your dust control by keeping it properly marked and by filling potholes with rock. Tama County's Dust Control Policy can be found on the county's website.
