

Dear Administrators and Teachers,

It is time to begin scheduling for the SY23/24 year. STARBASE Peterson works with schools and districts throughout the greater Colorado Springs area. Now that interest in our program has grown, and we potentially have more classes than we can accommodate, DoD guidelines require we give priority to Title I schools.

- ➤ Priority will be given to CSSD11 **Title I Schools** as CSSD11 is the home district for families living on Peterson SFB. Dates are offered to those schools on a first come/first served basis.
- Secondary priority is given to all other districts' Title 1 Schools on a first come/first served basis as space permits.
- Non-Title I Schools that submit a request by the deadline will be offered dates based on first come/first served basis as space permits.
- Any school that does not indicate Title I status, regardless of actual Title I status, will be placed with our waiting list and may be offered dates to attend STARBASE, space available, after all schools meeting the registration deadline have been scheduled.
- ➤ Any school, regardless of Title I status, not submitting a registration request by the deadline (March 9, 2023 by 3:00 p.m.) will be placed on our waiting list and may be offered dates on a space available basis after all schools meeting the registration deadline have been scheduled.
- > We cannot guarantee space for additional classes added after we schedule your school.
- > Schools must agree to fulfill the commitment to five full days of instruction
- > DOD regulations define a class as 20-35 students. Our capacity is a maximum 32 students per room.
 - Classes of fewer than 20 may be augmented by combining with another school when required.
 Your school will be notified if this becomes necessary so we may assist your school in finding a solution.
 - Please be aware we may divide 3 smaller classes into 2 larger groups to facilitate scheduling.

STARBASE Peterson understands these updated school registration request guidelines are more rigorous than previous years and we apologize for any inconvenience. The local STARBASE program has grown and more schools every year are participating in our hands-on/minds-on STEM program to enhance and support classroom instruction. However, this means that we may have more classes interested than we have space for during the school year.
