

SUMMER CAMP REGISTRATION PACKET

Welcome! STARBASE is a free Department of Defense (DOD) community outreach program that provides an exciting and inspiring hands-on curriculum that emphasizes the application of Science, Technology, Engineering/Art Design, and Mathematics (STEAM).

Please CAREFULLY read all information provided in this packet.

STARBASE PETERSON offers a variety of extension and outreach programs throughout the year including 4-day Summer Camps. Camp hours are from **9:00a.m.** to **2:00p.m.** either Monday-Thursday <u>or</u> Tuesday-Friday.

Dependents of military (including allied forces stationed in Colorado) and civilian/contractor employees are given priority for STARBASE Peterson Summer Camps. Dependents of non-military/civil service may be admitted to summer camps on a space-available basis.

Parents or guardians must provide transportation to and from Peterson Space Force Base. Anyone without base access MUST arrange for base access at least two weeks prior to summer camp dates. Please plan to arrive promptly at, but not before, 9:00 a.m. and pick up your child on time at 2:00 p.m. Students may not be left outside the building unattended at any time. There is NO before or after care for summer camps. *For families residing in Peterson SFB base housing, please contact us for information regarding walkers or bike riders.

Students must bring their own sack lunches, snacks, and beverages. Please be aware there is <u>no microwave</u> or refrigerator available for student use. No candy, gum, beverages, food, or snacks are allowed during class time. Time will be scheduled during the day for snack and lunch breaks. *Students may keep plain water in a fully closeable, spillproof bottle at their desks.

Each student must submit a completed registration and demographic form. Please ensure the Emergency Contact information is completed with a second adult in case of emergencies. *Forms without emergency contact information will not be accepted.

Weather Issues and Delays

In case of weather-related problems, STARBASE Peterson will cancel classes/camp for the day. Please be aware of our weather policies:

- Please check local weather stations for closure announcements; contact the STARBASE staff via email if you are unsure about weather status.
- If <u>Peterson is on a TWO-HOUR DELAY or CLOSED</u>, then STARBASE is cancelled.
- We will do our best to reschedule your class/camp if we have available open dates.
 - o Rescheduling of a class/camp is not guaranteed.

STARBASE CODE OF CONDUCT

Please discuss with your students the following code of conduct prior to their participation in STARBASE Academy. Students are expected to follow the STARBASE Peterson Code of Conduct at all times:

- No gum is allowed at STARBASE at any time.
- Only fully closeable bottles with WATER are allowed at desks during class time.
- STARBASE students are not authorized to leave the STARBASE facility or STARBASE tour sites for any reason without a STARBASE staff member or parent/guardian.
- Students will be respectful of STARBASE staff and equipment. Disruptive behavior, swearing, damage to STARBASE equipment, physical threats to students or staff, and other behaviors that would be inappropriate at school are unacceptable at STARBASE Peterson.
- Repeated negative actions or behaviors will result in following the Code of Conduct Action Plan as outlined below.
- For any negative action which is severe or creates risk to other students or staff
 members, the STARBASE staff maintains the right to immediately remove the student
 from the activity, parents notified to pick up the student, and not invite the student
 back to STARBASE without proceeding through the Code of Conduct action plan.
