
#### 2025 VININGS VILLAGE HOA YEAR IN REVIEW



### PERMANENT BIOGRAPHY & ART EXHIBIT

VVHA partnered with Cobb Landmarks and Kennesaw State University to create a pocket park next to the historic marker honoring the legacy of folk artist Nellie Mae Rowe. Located at the former site of Rowe's home on Paces Ferry Road, the storyboards serve as a tribute to Rowe's life and artistic vision. State and Georgia Humanities grants funded the project.



## ZONING CASES AND SITE PLANS

Consulted with Cobb county and the developer of "Riverview Village" (former Kroger Center) to reduce the density of the planned mixed-use development and to add a dedicated left turn lane on Paces Mill. The developer agreed to eliminate the walking trails adjacent to nearby Stillhouse homes and to meet with VVHA & Cobb Police on security protocols for the new development.



# COBB BIOSOLIDS INCINERATION PROJECT

Actively working with Cobb Commissioner Allen and the Water System Director to advocate for environmental safety assurances in the multi-million-dollar county project to implement "biosolids incineration" at the RL Sutton Water Reclamation Facility adjacent to Vinings. Scheduled project completion is 2029.



## GEORGIA POWER CO ENHANCEMENTS

Worked with Georgia Power Co to replace old power poles & equipment, clear excess vegetation, and move vulnerable overhead lines to enhance service reliability in targeted areas of Vinings.



### NANCY STILL BRONZE SCULPTURE RELOCATION

A Vinings area landowner in the early 1800s, Nancy Still represents the plight of the Cherokee nation & the Trail of Tears in 1835. The Paces West Office Buildings agreed to donate the bronze statue to Vinings. We are working with the county to relocate the life-size sculpture in front of the Vinings Library.
