Twitty & Lynn Bring Classic Country Music to The Legacy Theater

The country music tribute show, Twitty and Lynn, will return to the stage of The Legacy Theater at 7 p.m. Saturday, June 22.

The Twitty & Lynn show gives country music fans the chance to look back in time. Tre Twitty is the grandson of Conway Twitty, and Tayla Lynn is the granddaughter of Loretta Lynn. Tre and Tayla's show has recreated the unique chemistry of their grandparents.

It is a loving tribute to singers they refer to as "Poppy" and "Memaw."

"I think of us as the ambassadors of the Twitty and

Lynn names. We're just the new version of what they've already established," Tre said. "But we also want to be caretakers of the past."

Before her death in 2022, Country Music Hall of Famer Loretta Lynn helped her grand-daughter Tayla and Tre Twitty with their show that brings back the look and sound of the original duo.

"Memaw just loved (the show). It brought up so many memories of Conway for her and took her back to a place in her life when they were building their careers," Tayla said.

Tayla has been singing since she was a child. She first heard Tre sing at Loretta's ranch, when he was doing a tribute "Remembering Conway." They began singing together in 2018 and debuted at The Grand Ole Opry in 2022.




