



RESPITE

What is Respite?

Services which offer temporary or substitute supports or living arrangements for care recipients in order to provide a brief period of relief or rest for caregivers.

Types of Respite:

In-Home Care, Adult Day Care and Institutional Stays. Funding may be available to cover a portion of these services.

In-Home Care- A professional caregiver who comes to the home to perform non-medical services such as supervision, light cleaning, cooking and laundry.

Adult Date Care- A center that provides professional care for adults during a portion of the day. **Institutional Stay-** A temporary stay at a skilled nursing or assisted living facility.

SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING

What is supplemental funding?

Funding that can be used to purchase an item that will assist in the care of an older adult, adult with a disability or children being raised by a grandparent.

Examples of items purchased for a grandparent raising a grandchild include (but not limited to): school registration fees, daycare, uniforms, bunk beds, school clothes

What is supportive counseling?

Guidance on resources available in your community to navigate new challenges in your role as a caregiver or grandparent raising a grandchild.

- -Local support groups-Individual counseling options
- -Local educational classes on Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia
- -Adaptive Equipment for the Home
- -Self care opportunities
- -Helpful publications for caregivers



-An adult who is providing informal care (not paid/professional) for an adult age 60 or older or caring for an adult age 18-59 who has a severe disability.

-A grandparent or step-grandparent age 55 or older (or an older relative of a child by blood, marriage, adoption or has a legal relationship with the child), lives with the child or is raising the child informally.

-A relative age 55 or older who provides care for an adult with a severe disability who is between the ages of 19 and 59.

A Care Recipient must be:

- Age 60 or older and meet the eligibility criteria of impairment in ADLs and IADL's.
- Between the ages of 19-59 years of age and have a severe disability, Alzheimer's disease or related disorder with neurological and/or organic brain dysfunctions.
- -A child who is being raised by a grandparent, step grandparent or older relative (age 55+)

"I think of us as the ambassadors of the Twitty and Lynn names. We're just the new version of what they've already established," Tre says. "But we also want to be caretakers of the past."






