

What is Respite?

Services which offer temporary or substitute supports or living arrangements for care recipients in order to provide a brief period of relief or rest for

Types of Respite:

In-Home Care, Adult Day Care and Institutional Stays. Funding may be available to cover a portion of these services.

In-Home Care- A professional caregiver who comes to the home to perform non-medical services such as supervision, light cleaning, cooking and laundry.

Adult Date Care- A center that provides professional care for adults during a portion of the day. Institutional Stay- A temporary stay at a skilled nursing or assisted living facility.


