Fallen Soldiers 5K Raises \$22,000

MACOMB, IL - - Western Illinois University kicked off Military Appreciation week by hosting the 13th annual Fallen Soldiers 5K, on Saturday, Nov. 2. This year's event drew in more than 450 participants and raised more than \$22,000 for student scholarships.

Isaac Jones of Table Grove finished first with an impressive time of 16:37. Meg Simmons, a freshman Agricultural Business major from Macomb, was the top female finisher with a time 21:30.

Proceeds from this annual event support the Fallen Soldiers Scholarship Fund, which provides scholarships for WIU's veteran and military service students. In its first 13 years, the Fallen Soldiers 5K has raised more than \$237,000 for scholarships.

The event and scholarship fund honor the memory of WIU alumni Capt. Derek Dobogai and Lt. Col. Robert Baldwin, who were both killed in the line of duty.
