Macomb Observes Memorial Day

Macomb American Legion Post 6 and Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 1921 co-sponsored a Memorial Day ceremony on Monday at the American Legion Post. The keynote address was given by State Representative Dan Swanson, a retired Army lieutenant colonel.

Swanson called it "a day of remembrance to honor those who gave their all.' He said America's greatness came out of heroism and sacrifice. "It is America who the world looks to for help and leadership," Swanson said. "And America always answers the call...We hope to

ILLINOIS GOVERNOR'S CHALLENGE Preventing Suicide Among Service Members, Veterans and their Families

Confidential Hotline and Customized Training Resources Provide Vital Support

To further respond and provide support to the military community, the Illinois Governor's Challenge Campaign announced recently the availability of Online Training Resources for organizations interested in supporting Service Members, Veterans, and their Families (SMVF). The training effort is in tandem with promoting the Veterans Crisis hotline specifically serving SMVF.

"Since kicking off the Illinois Governor's Challenge in November, my office, the Illinois Department of Human Services, and the Illinois Department of Veterans' Affairs have worked in partnership to implement a comprehensive approach to combat suicide among Service Members, Veterans, and their Families," said Governor JB Pritzker. "The crisis hotline and training resources are an integral piece to increasing access to mental health resources across the state."

This statewide Veterans Crisis Line serves

SMVFs, their friends, and those who support them and are struggling with mental health issues such as depression, anxiety, and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD). The crisis line is free, confidential, and available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Callers do not need to be enrolled in VA services to use the Veterans Crisis Line. For support, SMVFs can call 988 directly and then press 1, text 838255, or chat online www.veteranscrisisline.net with a trained professional.

"According to the Centers for Disease Control, the suicide rate among males in 2021 was approximately four times higher than the rate among females. Males make up 50% of the population but nearly 80% of suicides. Rates of suicide among Illinois' military population is 26 percent. Our goal is to eliminate suicide," said Dr. Teresa Glaze, Ph.D, LCSW and Campaign Team Leader. "Suicide is preventable

Altercation leads to Mob **Action and Aggravated Battery Arrest**

On 05/26/23 at approximately 9:48 PM, Macomb Police officers were dispatched to 505 N. Johnson St. in reference to an altercation that had occurred. It was reported that someone had been stabbed during the altercation.

The investigation determined that a couple had been walking in the 500 block of N. Johnson St and were having a verbal argument. This argument was observed by Treshawn Howard, and possibly others. Howard, instead of calling the police and observing, physically intervened and a fight ensued. Howard, and potentially other suspects, began beating the male and female that had been having the verbal disagreement. During the fight, suspects attacked the couple with a large speaker box, striking them. The female, afraid for her life, resorted to using a knife to defend herself. Howard was treated and released from MDH and arrested for Mob Action and Aggravated

This incident is still under investigation and more arrests are likely.

All subjects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

The state representative and former military leader ended his talk by saying, "God bless those who gave their lives to make America strong...Always remember and never forget."

and through these new resources, the Governor's Challenge will continue to raise awareness and reduce stigma, as well as provide tools for people that want to support those that serve and have served our country, as well as to their family and friends."

The Governor's Challenge has partnered with PsychArmor, a national nonprofit providing education and training to improve the outcomes of military-connected individuals, to offer free online courses to prevent suicide among SMVFs. The online training program is open to all individuals, with short courses geared toward healthcare professionals, mental health providers, social workers, educators, clergy, community members, and others who work with service members and veterans in need or their families. Participants can receive certification and continuing education credits. Training courses are available by visiting https://illinois-smvf.psycharmor.org.

The training program covers various topics including the signs and symptoms of mental health conditions such as PTSD, depression, and anxiety. Participants will learn how to recognize these symptoms in Service Members and Veterans and how to provide appropriate support and resources. The program will also cover strategies for suicide prevention, crisis intervention, and safe gun storage.

"The crisis line and online training resources are just two components of a larger effort to combat Service Member and Veteran suicide in Illinois," said Terry Prince, Director of the Illinois Department of Veterans' Affairs. "By increasing awareness and knowledge about the unique challenges that Service Members and Veterans face, Illinoisans can work together to prevent suicide and provide the care and support that our Service Members, Veterans, and their Families deserve."




