



#### **IDOT, ISP: 'U Drive. U Text. U Pay.'**

#### April is Distracted Driving Awareness Month

SPRINGFIELD – The Illinois Department of Transportation is teaming up with the Illinois State Police and more than 200 local law enforcement agencies to promote Distracted Driving Awareness Month, reminding motorists to "Drop it and Drive." Throughout April, law enforcement officers will work together to enforce texting and distracted driving laws.

"Distracted driving is one of the leading causes of crashes on our roads today," said Steve Travia, IDOT's Director of Highways and Chief Engineer. "During Distracted Driving Awareness Month, police will boost enforcement efforts, stopping anyone they see texting and driving. Remember: 'U Drive. U Text. U Pay."

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, between 2012 and 2021, approximately 32,000 lives were lost in crashes involving distracted drivers. Everyone has the potential for distracted driving crashes, but those between the ages of 16 and 24 are especially at risk. If you need to text, pull over to a safe location, or if you have a passenger, consider appointing a designated texter. Whatever the solution, don't text and drive.

"While driving, many of us are tempted to check our phone, just quickly, when we hear that ding of notification," said ISP Division of Patrol Col. Chris Owen. "That quick look could cause a crash and cost you your life or the lives of others. Whatever that message is on your phone, it's not more important than your life or the lives of others. Keep your eyes on the road and your hands on the wheel."

To keep your attention on the road, remember these tips:

If you are expecting a text or need to send one, pull over and park your car in a safe location.


Do not engage in social media scrolling or messaging while driving.

Cell phone use is habit-forming. Struggling to not text and drive? Activate your phone's "Do Not Disturb" feature.

The Illinois distracted driving campaign is funded with federal traffic safety funds administered by IDOT.

#### **Choirs Masterworks Rutter's Requiem April 5**

MACOMB, IL - The Western Illinois University School of Music will present a Spring Choral Masterworks Concert at 7:30 p.m. Friday, April 5, at Wesley United Methodist Church.

The program will feature John Rutter's Requiem, performed by the Western Illinois University Singers, Concert Choir and Chamber Ensemble, conducted by WIU Music Professor Brian J. Winnie, with WIU Music Assistant Director Elisabeth Marshall, soprano and Gayle Cooper, organ. The WIU Chamber Singers will also perform William Byrd's Mass for Four Voices.

Byrd and Rutter are exemplary composers of English choral music from very different historical periods. This concert features two versions of the mass, one incorporating the traditional mass ordinary text and one that includes the mass ordinary and mass proper texts commonly used in the Requiem Mass.

Byrd was a Renaissance composer and organist most well-known for his sacred motets and masses and further development of the English madrigal.

Rutter's Requiem, written in 1985, was given its first complete performance in Dallas in October of that year. Its focus is not on the final judgment and therefore excludes the traditional Dies Irae (Day of Judgement). Rather, it incorporates movements based on scriptural texts - Psalm 130 (Out of the Deep) and Psalm 23 (The Lord Is My Shepherd), and excerpts from the 1662 Book of Common Prayer.


This performance is open free for general audience seating.


