"The focus groups clearly showed a disconnect between the academic and athletic aspects of the college, and the new brand and more casual style and tone used throughout our branding better integrate and unite academics and athletics under one name: Sandburg. We're excited to unveil our new website as well, which will showcase this new look with the same great opportunities Sandburg has provided students for more than 50 years."

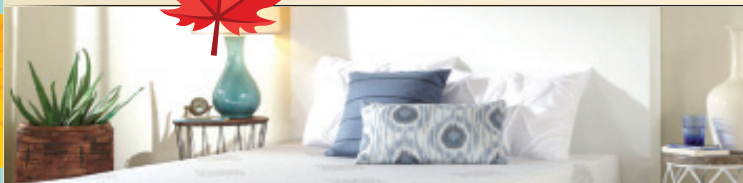

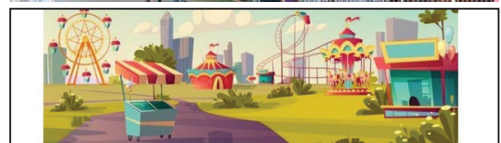
