WIU Social Media Lab Promotes Accurate Internet Access Funding



MACOMB, IL -- The Social Media Lab at Western Illinois University is working to spread awareness about and assist with the Broadband Equity, Access and Deployment (BEAD) challenge process. The State of Illinois was awarded \$1.04 billion in federal BEAD funds to ensure every Illinoisan has access to high-speed internet.

A challenge process has been enacted to

determine where the funds will be spent over the next five years to ensure the communities in need of funding are accurately identified.

"There are many underserved communities in West Central Illinois in need of these funds. This is a chance to speak up and make our needs heard," Communication Professor Josh Averbeck said.

There are thousands of households that need high-speed internet access in West Central Illinois. The new funding would provide fiber-optic cable, far exceeding current infrastructure capabilities.

"Saving the Planet" Art Gallery on Display Feb. 27-March 29

MACOMB, IL - The Western Illinois University Art Gallery, will host WIU Professor Emeritus Fred Jones for their solo exhibition, "Saving the Planet" on display Tuesday, Feb. 27 - Friday, March 29. Admission is open free to the public.

A reception for the artist will be held from 4:30-6 p.m. Saturday, March 2. The artist will speak about their work at 5 p.m.

This exhibition is a presentation of "A Journal of the Spiritual and the Sublime in Nature", a collection of art reproductions, essays, quotations and statements.

Jones earned a National Diploma in Design in 1961 from Cardiff College of Art in Wales, U.K. and an Art Teachers Diploma from the University of Wales in 1962. In 1965 he earned a Master of Education degree from the University of Pittsburgh. In 1970-71, Jones attended the University of Wisconsin-Madison, completing a Master of Fine Art in printmaking. In 1979, he attended Atelier 17 Paris. In 1987, he returned to the University of Wisconsin as an Honorary Fellow to study Computer Mediated Art.

"We have households who cannot interact with the global marketplace, access telehealth services or enroll in education opportunities because the internet service is either unreliable or incapable of high-speed service," Averbek said.

The Illinois Office of Broadband and the Illinois Broadband Lab have created maps showing the internet capabilities of each household and community anchor institution in the state. Community anchor institutions include libraries, hospitals, schools and government buildings. Any location can challenge the accuracy of the map.

Individuals are encouraged to perform speed tests to check if they are receiving the internet speed they are paying for in their service agreement.

If individuals wish to submit a challenge, contact Professor Averbek at jm-averbeck@wiu.edu or 309-298-5203. Challenges may only be submitted through those registered with the Office of Broadband.

"This may seem like a cumbersome step, but it provides an intermediate to ensure the proper information is submitted and challenges will be successful," Averbek said.

The challenge process begins Tuesday, Feb. 27 and is only open for two weeks.


Little Creek Alpacas Earth Day Farm Fundraiser

Come out to Little Creek Alpacas on Sat., April 20th from 1pm-5pm for a fun afternoon celebrating nature, the Earth, alpacas, and art! Take a hike around the pond, go fishing, collect rocks & sticks, paint rocks, build a fairy hut, play in the sand, feed the alpacas, and more! Bring a cooler and have an alpaca picnic. It's a day to have fun around the farm and immerse yourself in nature and art. The farm store will be open in the red shelter if you need any alpaca products. Hickory Ridge Homestead will be coming out with all her fiber goodies, and spinning yarn with her angora rabbit. She'll have drop spindles for sale too, and can even show you how to use one.

Tickets are \$40 per vehicle and limited to 20 vehicles. You must purchase a ticket ahead of time to attend. <https://square.link/u/x3q4Fr9W>

Carpool to save money, gas, and emit less emissions. Bring your own food & drinks. No pets, no smoking, no chasing the alpacas. Price of ticket includes admission for everyone in your vehicle, a cup of grain for each person to feed the alpacas with, and free access to the painting rocks station & build your own fairy hut station. Please note, it's your job to find the materials in nature to build with (sticks, rocks, leaves, feathers, whatever your heart fancies), we'll have glue guns, twine, yarn, a small drill, and other things to help you build with. A handicap accessible port-a-potty will be available.

This fun Earth Day event is also a fundraiser for our farm to repair Sunny Beach after the drought last year, and to run rural water to our alpaca barns since our well pump broke. I'm currently hauling 64 gallons of water daily from our house to the barn for all the alpacas.




