SRC Offers Food Service Manager Certification Courses in Macomb

Macomb - Spoon River College is offering a class called "Food Service Sanitation Manager Certification" on Monday, January 22nd from 8:30am-3:30pm at the Spoon River College Outreach Center in Macomb.

All establishments which serve food must have one certified person on the premises at all times. In order to obtain a new FSSMC Certificate, you must complete an eight-hour ServSafe® IDPH approved course and pass an exam accredited under the standards developed and adopted by the Conference for Food Protection with a score of 75% or better. This course, instructed by I Food Manager (IFM), covers up-to-date information on safe food handling, preparation, food storage, per-

sonal hygiene, and the prevention of food borne illnesses. Completion of this course does not guarantee you will pass the exam. Students are advised to utilize any study materials provided before attending class. Courses are instructed by Wanda Adkins of IFM.

Additional classes will be held on February 26th, March 25th, and May 6th.





































SRC Offers Woodworking Classes in Rushville

Rushville-Spoon River College is offering the below Woodworking classes. New this semester is the Advanced Woodworking class for those that have already taken our Beginning Woodworking class.

Students will be given hands-on training and discuss woodworking planning and techniques, as well as, complete their own woodworking project utilizing the skills and techniques learned in class.

Advanced Woodworking will be held on Monday's, January 29th-April 1st from 6-9:15pm. Students will build upon their previous woodworking skills. In Advanced Woodworking, students will select, design, and construct their own project. Topics covered include; planning and design, selecting materials, review of shop safety, material assembly and final surface preparation. Students will be given hands-on training and discuss

woodworking planning and techniques, as well as, complete their own advanced woodworking project utilizing the skills and techniques learned in class. REQUIREMENTS: Beginning Woodworking class.
