McDonough District Hospital Donates Kinesiology Equipment to WIU

MACOMB, IL – Students in the Western Illinois University Department of Kinesiology are learning on new equipment, thanks to a recent gift from McDonough District Hospital.

In February 2024, the staff at McDonough District Hospital donated an electrocardiogram testing system, including a GE Medical Systems EKG testing computer, a GE72100 motorized treadmill and a Laerdal CPR Simulation Manikin.

"We are proud to support the Western Illinois University Kinesiology department by donating

our GE Stress machine and treadmill. We are excited to support WIU's commitment to education on stress testing and are confident this equipment will greatly benefit the students and teachers. We look forward to seeing the positive impact this contribution will have," MDH Director of Cardio-pulmonary Nicole Minnis, RT(R) RVT RDMS(ABD, OB/GYN) RDCS, said.

This equipment is now housed in the Human Performance Lab in Brophy Hall and is being used by both undergraduate and graduate students in exercise science courses. Staff from MDH came to campus to train WIU students and staff on how to properly use
