McDonough County Health Department Observes National Food Safety Education Month

MACOMB- September is National Food Safety Education Month and the McDonough County Health Department would like to remind residents to use these four simple steps to keep food safe: Clean, Separate, Cook, and Chill.

CLEAN: Wash hands for 20 seconds with soap and warm water before handling any food or eating. Wash all food preparation surfaces, utensils and dishes after each use. Rinse all fruits and vegetables with clean water before preparing or eating them.

SEPARATE: Use separate cutting boards, utensils and plates for produce, meat, poultry, seafood and eggs. Always wash surfaces thoroughly after they come into contact with raw meat. Keep raw meats separate in your grocery cart and bags, as well as in your refrigerator. Never consume raw batter with egg as an

ingredient when baking!

COOK: The only way to tell if the meat is "done" is to check it with a probe thermometer. Cook chicken and casseroles to 165°F, ground beef and pork to 155°F, eggs, fish,

lamb, and cuts of beef to 145°F, and plant foods to 135°F. Keep hot food at 135°F or above once cooked. Reheat all foods to 165°F to make sure any harmful bacteria introduced post-cooking are killed.

CHILL: Refrigerate perishable foods within 2 hours (1 hour in the heat of the summer). Don't overstuff your refrigerator- air circulation is important to cool foods quickly. Always thaw meat in the refrigerator, under cold, running water, or in the microwave immediately before cooking. Discard foods that aren't consumed within one week of preparation or opening (hot






