**BREAKING NEWS:
Decision Released on
Officer Involved Shooting**

A decision has been released from Special Prosecutor Jonathan H. Barnard of the Office of Illinois State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor (ILSAAP) regarding charges in the March 16 officer-involved shooting of four-year-old Terrell Miller of Macomb. Barnard shared in a letter with State's Attorney Matt Kwacala, which was released today (July 23), that "there is no basis for criminal action or prosecution that is supportable under the facts of this case against any of the law enforcement officers involved in this tragic case." 
