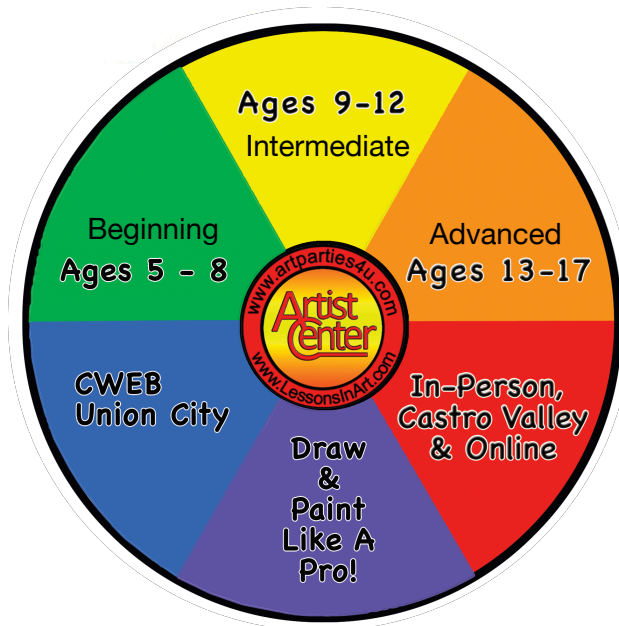

## CURRICULUM

All students begin to learn shapes/ dimensional shapes, perspective and values/ tones. Each class begins with the warm up given as a worksheet at first class.

The worksheet is repetitive and used in each class to establish the thinking of an artist. Construction of figures/heads, animals and still life are the subject matter. With the use of the artists' imagination, students learn to tell a story using their drawing skills that are acquired through this process. Story boards and comic book techniques are emphasized as well. Students learn at their own pace and Individual expression is emphasized throughout the program. Students must have an interest in art.

Choose between a 5,6,8 weekly and monthly program. Single day camps are available excluding holidays. Available Online during In-person schedule. To participate in this study of art is to put the emphasis on drawing.
