

New England Fall Foliage

October 9-17, 2021 9 Days

DAY 1 VIRGINIA / DINNER: Your exciting tour to New England begins this morning. Reservations have been made for your rest stops and lunch on your own before reaching our first overnight stop in Virginia. Dinner is included this evening. (D)

DAY 2 SHENANDOAH VALLEY / CABELA'S / NEW JERSEY: The colors of fall begin today as we travel the length of the Shenandoah Valley. Then we travel to Hamburg, Pennsylvania, for a stop at Cabela's. We then continue to New Jersey for our overnight accommodations. (B)

DAY 3 HILDENE / RUTLAND: This morning we travel through the beautiful Pocono Mountains and arrive in Manchester, Vermont for a stop at Hildene, the stately home of Robert Todd Lincoln. The Georgian Revival mansion contains original furnishings, a 1,000 pipe organ and family memorabilia. We overnight in the Rutland, Vermont area. (B)

DAY 4 COLD HOLLOW CIDER / STOWE VERMONT / BEN & JERRY'S ICE CREAM / LINCOLN: Today we continue our scenic Vermont drive as we arrive at the small town of Waterbury. Here we visit the Cold Hollow Cider Mill, which features a large cider press, a cider jelly making room, natural ingredient bakery and an impressive retail store. Next, we visit the small town of Stowe, where we have lunch and shopping on our own. This afternoon we take a tour of the factory that produces America's favorite ice cream, Ben & Jerry's. We'll see how it all started in this little Vermont town. We spend the night in Lincoln, New Hampshire

and have dinner included this evening. (B,D)

DAY 5 KANCAMAGUS HIGHWAY / WHITE MOUNTAINS / FREEPORT MAINE: Today we travel New Hampshire's most scenic drive the Kancamagus Highway, which was declared a Scenic Byway by the U.S. Forest Service. We continue through the White Mountains to North Conway and continue to Freeport, Maine. Here we visit a beautiful coastal Maine village with over 200 upscale outlets, designer shops, great restaurants and casual cafes. Home to world-famous L.L.Bean; we will enjoy an authentic Maine experience. We overnight in Maine. (B)

DAY 6 STURBRIDGE VILLAGE / SCRANTON: Today we visit Old Sturbridge Village which is a "must-see" destination to experience early New England life from 1790-1840. One of the country's largest living history museums, Old Sturbridge Village has historians in costume, 59 antique buildings, three water-powered mills, and a working farm. We view antiques, tour heirloom gardens, meet heritage breed farm animals, and enjoy hands-on crafts. We overnight in the Scranton, Pennsylvania area. (B)

DAY 7 HERSHEY / LANCASTER / AMISH TOUR / DUTCH APPLE DINNER THEATRE: This morning we arrive in Hershey, Pennsylvania--the "Chocolate Capital of the World"! We have a leisurely drive to Lancaster and by lunchtime you'll be good and hungry as we sit down to a delicious home-cooked Amish meal at one of the local Amish res-

taurants. This afternoon we meet our local guide as we begin with sightseeing in the Pennsylvania Amish country. Tonight we will enjoy a dinner and Broadway style production at the Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre. (B,L,D)

DAY 8 GETTYSBURG BATTLEFIELD / LUNCH - DOBBIN HOUSE / GETTYSBURG VISITORS CENTER / CYCLORAMA: This morning we travel to Gettysburg, the scene of the most decisive battle of the Civil War. We tour the battlefield

and learn about the largest battle ever fought on American soil. Lunch is included at the Dobbin House, Gettysburg's oldest, most historic home. We'll visit the Gettysburg Visitors Center and Cyclorama, a 360 degree painting depicting the Battle of Gettysburg. We spend the night in Virginia. (L)

DAY 9 HEARTWOOD / HOME: Today we stop by Heartwood which is the Southwest Virginia Artisan Gateway located in Abingdon, Virginia. We arrive home late this afternoon. (B)
