1 ARKANSAS / DINNER: We depart this morning for the scenic southwest, full of adventure and unparalleled beauty. We overnight in Arkansas where we have a get-acquainted dinner. (D)

2 OKLAHOMA CITY / NATIONAL MEMORIAL / COWBOY HALL OF FAME: Oklahoma is our destination today as we tour the capital city of this wonderful state. Our tour is to include the Oklahoma City National Memorial which was built in remembrance of the victims, survivors and rescuers of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building bombing in 1995; also we visit the National Cowboy Hall of Fame. We overnight in Clinton, Ok. (B)

3 TEXAS / NEW MEXICO / SANTA FE: Westward Ho! As we travel across the panhandle of Texas into the land of enchantment and the state of New Mexico. Late afternoon finds us in Santa Fe, the capital of New Mexico where we enjoy the next two nights. (B)

4 GUIDED TOUR OF SANTA FE / SAN MIGUEL MISSION / STATE CAPITAL: Our day begins with a guided tour of historic Santa Fe. Our local guide will point out highlights to include the Palace of the Governors, The oldest Government Building in the United States; San Miguel Mission, The Oldest Church still in use in the United States; The State Capital Building, the end of the famous Old Santa Fe Trail. The afternoon is free for you to explore the town of Santa Fe. (B)

5 PETRIFFED FOREST / FLAGSTAFF ARIZONA: We depart Santa Fe for a spectacular drive through the Petrified Forest National Park and the Painted Desert. Here we discover an abundance of colorful, petrified logs that have been buried for centuries under sediments rich in volcanic ash. Our hotel awaits us in Flagstaff, AZ. (B)

6 THE GRAND CANYON / LAS VEGAS: Today we discover one of the world's most outstanding spectacles, The Grand Canyon. This afternoon we see Hoover Dam a modern engineering marvel that supplies power for millions of people in the Southwest. We travel on to Las Vegas, NV for the next two nights. (B)

7 LOCAL GUIDED TOUR OF LAS VEGAS / AFTERNOON FREE: This morning we have a local tour of Las Vegas. Then the afternoon is free for you to do what you would like to do. There are many things to see and do. There is never a moments rest in Las Vegas where a never-ending array of attractions that await your attention. (B)

8 SEDONA ARIZONA / PINK JEEP RIDE / RED ROCK CANYON: We depart for Sedona, AZ where we board our world famous Pink Jeeps for a guided journey through the breath taking Red Rock Canyon to the top of Mo-gollon Rim. Here we enjoy the natural wonders of Sedona's unforgettable panoramic views. You will have time to relax and view the beautiful red rock mountains and shop in the assorted shops that line Main Street. We overnight here in Sedona. (B)

9 MONTEZUMA CASTLE NATIONAL MONUMENT / TUCSON: This morning we visit Montezuma Castle National Monument, the major cliff dwellings in Arizona. More than 800 years old, these are probably the best preserved cliff dwellings in the southwest. Then we drive south to Phoenix, Arizona's state capital. We see the Capitol Building, which is built of native stone and situated in a landscape area that includes a large variety of native trees, shrubs, and cacti. This evening we arrive in Tucson for dinner and our night's lodging. (CB,D)

10 SAGUARO CACTUS / SONORA DESERT MUSEUM / TOMBSTONE / LAS CRUCES: This morning we tour Saguaro National Monument. We'll drive the loop roads and walk the trails that take us past hundreds of the huge Saguaro Cactus, which grows only in the Sonora Desert. Next we visit the Arizona Sonora Desert Museum and get a close-up look at many live desert creatures in their native habitat. This afternoon we arrive in Tombstone, "The Town Too Tough To Die." We'll see a short multimedia presentation offering us a look at Tombstone's history. We'll also see the O.K. Corral where the Earps and the Clanton gang had their famous gunfight. Three-fourths of the land in Arizona is controlled by the Federal Government, giving assurance that America's natural wonders are protected for us to enjoy. We overnight in the Las Cruces, New Mexico area. (B)

11 NEW MEXICO / TEXAS / ABILENE: Today we travel out of New Mexico and into the state of Texas, where we overnight in the Abilene area. (B)

12 LONE STAR STATE / LITTLEROCK / MURRY'S DINNER THEATRE: This morning we drive through the Dallas-Ft Worth area before arriving in Little Rock, Arkansas, for the night. This evening we enjoy a delicious buffet dinner and fabulous live entertainment at Murry's Dinner Playhouse. (B,D)

13 HOME: This morning we travel our way back home. We begin to discuss the scenic wonders, panoramic views and grandeur of our Great Southwest Tour. We will arrive back home this evening from our CAREFREE VACATION. (B)
