Dear Ms. Weinberg:

We had an opportunity to review your scoliotic studies with views of the thoracic and lumbar spine dated 8/10/2015 and while on the neutral images, there is no significant scoliosis noted, on stress views, you were able to produce a scoliosis of approximately 24 degrees by Cobb angles at the T11/T12 level with convexity to the right. This is an impressive result in the resulting scoliotic angle, particularly due to the fact there was no significant scoliosis in the neutral views.

**IMPRESSION:** patient induced scoliosis of 24 degrees at the thoracolumbar level as described above with a Cobb angle of 24 degrees.
