Merjent Foundation Academic Scholarship

The Merjent Foundation Academic Scholarship is a one-time \$1,000.00 scholarship awarded to one individual who demonstrates academic success and intends to pursue a career in an environmental field.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for the Merjent Foundation Academic Scholarship, you must:

- Be an enrolled junior or senior at a select accredited four-year college or university nominated by a current Merjent staff member and approved by Merjent's scholarship committee. Eligible schools for the 2019/2020 scholarship include:
 - 1. Bemidji State University
 - 2. Gustavus Adolphus College
 - 3. Idaho State University
 - 4. North Dakota State University
 - 5. University of Minnesota- Morris
 - 6. University of Minnesota-Twin Cities
 - 7. University of Wisconsin- Stevens Point
 - 8. Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University
 - 9. Winona State University;
- Have a minimum cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale;
- Be enrolled in a degree program with the intention of pursuing a career in an environmental field. Degrees may include, but are not limited to: Environmental Sciences; Environmental Technology; Engineering; Biology; Fish and Wildlife Management; Soils; Anthropology; Archaeology; Education; Environmental Law; Geographic Information Systems; and

• Participate in a phone interview with the Merjent Foundation Board of Directors if chosen as a finalist.

Application Packet

The application packet must include:

- An essay / personal statement (400 to 800 words);
- A minimum of one recommendation letter;
- A copy of your current college transcript to demonstrate a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0/
 4.0; and
- The completed scholarship application form.

Essay / Personal Statement

We are interested in getting to know you, why you are interested in a career in the environmental field, and why you believe you are a good candidate for an environmental scholarship. Include information about your personal history, experiences, goals, and personal expectations that will help your reach your goals. Essays must contain 400 to 800 words.

Recommendation Letter

At least one recommendation letter is required. The letter must be from a teacher, employer, or another personal reference that can speak to your interest and experience in an environmental field. The letter may not be from a family member.

Application Format and Submittal Instructions

Applications shall be submitted via email by midnight on October 1, 2019.

- The email shall have the following subject line: Merjent Foundation Academic Scholarship Application

Merjent Foundation will send an email confirmation upon receipt of your application packet. Incomplete application packets will not be considered. Applications will be reviewed by the Merjent Foundation Board of Directors and the Scholarship Committee. Three finalists will be contacted via email by November 1, 2019, to schedule a phone interview. The scholarship recipient will be notified by email on or before December 1, 2019. The scholarship amount of \$1,000.00 will be sent directly to the college financial office and applied to the recipient's 2020 Winter semester tuition. Prior to submitting their application, the applicant is responsible for determining whether the scholarship would adversely affect their financial aid eligibility.

Application Ineligibility Students who have a parent or guardian that is a current Merjent, Inc. employee or students living at the same address as a current Merjent, Inc. employee are ineligible for this scholarship.
