Lead Line

Open to riders 8 and under. May not cross enter.

Entry Equitation Division

Riders not ready to trot in a group

Jr. Walk/Trot Division

Open to beginning riders under 18, may only cross enter walk/trot classes and/or Maiden classes.

Maiden Division

Open to beginning riders. Judged on equitation. Diagonals to count, Canter will be one at a time down long side of ring, leads will count. May only cross enter walk/trot classes.

Academy

Open to riders who do not own their own horse, riding a lesson horse or mount not owned by them. Judged on equitation. May cross enter other classes.

Novice Hunter

Open to all riders, judged on horses manners, way of going and suitability. No oxers or solid elements.

Future Hunter

Open to all riders, judged on horses manners, way of going and suitability. No oxers or solid elements. 18" vertical.

Starter Derby

Open to all but same horse/rider cannot be ridden in both Derbies.
\$25 entry fee, 50% of Entry fees goes to 1st thru 4th place!

Sr. Walk/Trot Division

Open to riders over 18, may not cross enter any jump classes.

Baby Green Hunter

Open to horses in their first year of their show career.

Hopeful Hunter 2'

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. No oxers or solid elements.

Open Equitation

Open to all riders on horse or pony. Judged on riders position and control of mount. X-rail or 2'

Adult Hunter

Open to riders over 18 years old.

Low & Open Hunter

Boxes and panels added. Open to all riders and horses

Hunter Derby

Open to all. \$25 entry fee, 50% of Entry fees goes to 1st thru 4th place!

Championship and reserve ribbons each division.
Ribbons 1st thru 6th in each class.

- No Add/Scratch once division has started
- \$25.00 schooling fee will be charged to horses that use facility and do not show.
- Negative coggins required.
- ASTM approved riding helmets must be worn when mounted. Informal attire acceptable with proper footwear.
- All entries are made at the owner's, rider's, and trainer's own risk. Management cannot be held responsible in any way for the loss, damage, or accident to horse/pony, rider, spectator, equipment, or vehicles brought to show grounds.
- No Dogs Allowed.
- No Stallions Allowed.
- Management reserves the right to reschedule, combine, divide, or cancel classes as needed.
- Child's age is as of December 1st the previous year.
- No martingales permitted in flat classes.
- No boots or bandages in hunter classes.
- All fees to be paid before classes or open check.
- 45.00 fee for returned checks.
- Judges decisions are final.
