Cannabis Figures That May Surprise You.

Now that our 'Neighbors to the North' have made recreational cannabis use legal, you might be surprised at how many here in the United States feel about cannabis.

Below are some recently collected statistics from various sources. As more states allow the legalization of both medical and recreational use of cannabis, expect these numbers to change...

- According to the American Legion, 82% of US veterans, veterans' family members and caregivers for veterans want cannabis as a federally legal treatment for PTSD, pain, and other ailments suffered by veterans.
- 83% of the above polled group think cannabis should be legal for medical treatment and recreational treatment (non-physician prescribed treatment) of veterans with PTSD.
- 92% of the above polled support the medical research of cannabis.
- A whopping 94% of Americans believe cannabis should be legal to prescribe by a physician anywhere in the United States.
- 60% of Americans support federal legalization for adults to use recreational cannabis.
- 97% of American adults believe that medical cannabis use can help decrease the opioid epidemic in the US.
- 73% of US Democrats support the federal legalization of recreational cannabis use – while only 43% of Republicans support the use of recreational cannabis. Independents weight in at 64%.
- 56% of Baby Boomers support the legalization of recreational cannabis use, with Gen X and Millennials weighing in at 66% and 70%.
- 44% of cannabis users say that they are more likely to be looking for a committed relationship than their non-cannabis using counterparts.
- 89% of Americans believe that opiate use has more negative affects (including addiction) than cannabis use.
- 52% of adults in states where medical cannabis is legal say that they have tried cannabis within the last 5 years.
- Regional surveys indicate that up to 95% of family practice medical doctors know little to nothing about cannabinoids and how they work.
