The 5 Types of Tours at PSAM:

- 1. "Highlights of the Collection" Adult Tour/Multi-Generational Families
- 2. School Tours
- 3. "Ask Me"
- 4. Specialist Tours (for a Specialist Exhibition)
- 5. Special Requested Tour



"Crafting / Creating a Tour"

The components of crafting a tour with **examples**:

- Selecting a Theme
- Introduction: "<u>Tell them what you're going to tell them."</u>
- Content and Transitions: "Tell them."
- Open-ended questioning techniques:
 - "What do you see?"
 - "What is going on here?"
 - "What was your first reaction to this artwork?"
 - "What words would you use to describe this artwork?"
 - "How would you describe this object (place, picture) to someone who has never seen it?"
 - "How are these objects / artworks alike?" "How are they different?"
 - (See "Questions to Ask About Art" handout in binder for more examples)
- Conclusion: "<u>Tell them what you told them</u>."
