Matt. 20:17 **And Jesus going up to Jerusalem took the twelve disciples apart in the way, and said unto them,**

18 Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death,

19 **And shall deliver him to the Gentiles to mock, and to scourge, and to crucify him: and the third day he shall rise again.**

27:1 When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:

27 **Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the common hall, and gathered unto him the whole band of soldiers.**

35 And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots:

45 **Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour.**

51 And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

54 **Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God.**
