## ★ Acceptable Materials

### FROM YOUR ART STUDIO

- ★ art supplies: paints (no house paint or spray paint), brushes, pencils, pens, sketchbooks, canvas, kid's craft items, clay
- ★ jewelry and jewelry parts, beads, tools and supplies
- ★ clay, sculpture tools
- ★ frames (glass must be secured in frame)
- ★ glass sheets less than 11" x 14"
- ★ studio equipment and tools
- ★ wood pieces under 3 feet long (no splinters, mold, dirt, nails)
- ★ mat board, foam core, pre-cut mats, mat cutters
- ★ easels, drafting tables, sketch boards
- ★ rulers, drafting supplies, cutting mats, paper cutters
- ★ storage containers
- ★ glue guns and sticks

### FROM YOUR KITCHEN

*Items must be clean. No common recyclables. No odors or stains.*

- ★ wine corks, metal bottle caps, plastic bottle caps, pop tabs
- ★ twist ties, rubber bands, bag clasps, magnets
- ★ clean tote bags, clean brown paper bags with handles
- ★ forks, spoons (no knives and no other kitchenware)
- ★ unused Ziploc-style plastic bags

### FROM YOUR LIVING ROOM

- ★ artwork: paintings, drawings, prints, sculpture, photographs
- ★ small musical instruments (working or not)
- ★ tiny toys: plastic animals, matchbox cars, Legos
- ★ vintage board games or contemporary board game pieces
- ★ posters, calendars, wallpaper, puzzles
- ★ non-decorated baskets, suitcases, cigar boxes
- ★ art/craft/science/DIY-related books, magazines, and zines
- ★ vases and decorative containers, fake flowers, rocks, shells
- ★ small mirrors

### FROM YOUR GARAGE

*No rust. No dangerous parts or chemicals.*

- ★ small, old machinery parts, gears, hardware, keys
- ★ tools in usable condition, new in package light bulbs
- ★ clean plant pots (no dirt residue, no thin plastic seedling flats)
- ★ buckets, barrels, containers, cord, wire, rope
- ★ sheet metal pieces, unused foil trays, small craft wood
- ★ tile (3" in size or smaller)

### FROM YOUR CRAFT STASH

- ★ stationery, scrapbooking materials, stickers, greeting cards, post cards, postage stamps, ephemera
- ★ leather scraps, upholstery bolts
- ★ glitter, craft kits, kid art supplies, crayons, markers
- ★ yarn and fabric larger than 1/2 yard (no clothing, clothing pieces, or fabric scraps) (please remove pins/needles)
- ★ working sewing machines, unused pillow forms
- ★ needlework, knitting, weaving, and sewing supplies such as buttons, elastic, velcro, hem tape, etc.
- ★ jewelry-making supplies and tools, finished or broken jewelry, watch/clock parts
- ★ gift items: wrapping paper, bows, decorative boxes, ribbon
- ★ seashells, driftwood, rocks, gems, wax
- ★ doll-making supplies, handmade dolls
- ★ stained glass, mosaic pieces, chalkboards, cork boards

### FROM YOUR ATTIC

*Please dust items and check for mold.*

- ★ analog equipment: record players, typewriters, phones, etc.
- ★ trophies, ribbons, medals, awards
- ★ old media, floppy disks, cords and cables
- ★ working overhead/digital projectors, screens
- ★ vintage: curiosities, books, pre-1970 magazines, tins, sunglasses
- ★ working: electric typewriters, small record players, radios
- ★ snapshots, slides, filmstrips, negatives, photo albums
- ★ DVDs, record albums, CDs, cassette tapes
- ★ VHS: only blank and non-mass market movies (i.e. home movies)
- ★ needlework, doilies, hankies, handmade items, scarves
- ★ vintage or handmade small tree ornaments (non-glass)
- ★ small sports balls like golf, tennis, baseball

### FROM YOUR OFFICE

- ★ office & school supplies: envelopes, folders, paper, staplers, scissors, erasers, tape, glue, rubber bands, clips, desk organizers, old letterhead, stickers, sticky notes, decor, etc.

### FROM YOUR BUSINESS

- ★ outdated swag, bags, signs, letters, stickers, labels, stamps
- ★ architecture and design samples, blueprints
- ★ spools, reels, cones, cardboard tubes (no TP tubes), clean lab, supplies
- ★ mannequins, display fixtures, stands, bookends
- ★ packing peanuts (please put in a shopping bag), bubble wrap

# X Unsuitable Materials

- X Glass sheets larger than 11" x 14"
- X Unframed mirrors larger than 11" x 14"
- X Wood pieces longer than 3 feet
- X Fabric scraps smaller than 1/2 yard, clothing, shoes, costumes, clothing scraps, umbrellas
- X Household cookware and dishes, glassware, bakeware, used plastic utensils, broken pottery/plates/glass/ceramics
- X Household recyclables (glass/plastic/junk mail/to-go containers, cans, egg cartons, etc.)
- X Food or containers that have ever housed food
- X Styrofoam, coolers, cold packs
- X Computers, printers, TVs, batteries, used toner/ink cartridges
- X Curtains, sheets, bedspreads, tablecloths, used pillows, towels, mattresses, mattress foam, hangers, used/new carpet
- X Finished, pre-fabricated holiday and decoration items (wreaths, trees, glass ornaments, figurines)
- X Oil or Latex-based house paint, solvents, car maintenance items
- X Lawn equipment, hoses, sprayers, garden decor, dried flowers
- X Contemporary, mass produced kids' toys, electronic toys, dolls, stuffed animals (exception: vintage, specialty, or handmade)
- X Lamp shades, light fixtures (exception: vintage or art lamps), broken/non-working light bulbs
- X Makeup, personal care items, perfumes, nail polish
- X Animal cages and toys, fish tanks, feeders, food tins, bedding
- X Used medical items, syringes, needles, pill bottles
- X Mercury-containing items like thermometers or thermostats
- X Fiberglass, concrete blocks, bricks, used tiles, particle board
- X Dried-up art paints and adhesives
- X Cleaning products, chemicals, unlabeled substances
- X Vacuums, appliances, furniture, non-working sewing machines
- X Sports equipment (exception: small game balls, wooden skis and racquets)
- X Cribs, playpens, bed frames, head/foot boards
- X Contemporary electronics, cell phones
