



Alta California, Touchstone of Architectural Heritage and Native Culture in a Premiere Edition combines the story of the 650-mile mission trails, El Camino Real's 'Spanish Mission Chain' with vintage images from tales of California's earliest settlements. The new edition introduces a story of California's historical roots and conquest of European discovery through the tumultuous 18th & 19th centuries of rapid changes inside the Golden State!

An action packed new edition recalls over fifty years of a Spanish, Mexican, and American epoch, uncovering Indigenous tribal heritage, impact and resiliency, within diversified Nations within traditional Native California.
