#### **Position Summary**

Mentors in the Family Residential program serve as consistent, positive role models for youth and families navigating behavioral health, family reunification, or housing instability. Clinical Mentors (Category 3) provide skill-building and emotional support aligned with therapeutic goals, while Social Mentors (Category 1-2) focus on relational development, modeling routines, and supporting daily functioning.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Build trusting relationships with residents through regular 1:1 and group interactions
- Engage residents in structured, interest-based activities that support emotional growth and life skills
- Support youth and parents with routines, transitions, communication, and social engagement
- Reinforce behavior plans and coping strategies created by therapists or behavior specialists
- Participate in daily programming, including meals, recreation, and reflection groups
- Communicate observations and progress with the broader treatment team
- Model respectful, strength-based communication and conflict resolution

## Compensation

- \$22–\$30/hour depending on experience, credentials, and mentor category (1–3)
- Part-time and full-time schedules available; flexible shifts including evenings and weekends

- High school diploma or equivalent (Category 1); Associate or Bachelor's Degree (Categories 2–3)
- Experience working with youth, families, or in residential/group home settings
- Strong interpersonal skills and emotional intelligence
