The Clinical Therapist provides therapeutic services to youth and families residing in Family Links' residential program. This role offers individual, group, and family therapy to address trauma, mental health, family reunification, and other social-emotional needs. Therapists work closely with case managers, mentors, and residential staff to develop treatment plans and help families thrive beyond their time in residence.

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct biopsychosocial assessments and develop individualized treatment plans
- Deliver trauma-informed therapy to youth and parents (individual, family, and group formats)
- Support family reunification, co-parenting, and attachment rebuilding
- Document clinical progress and maintain HIPAA-compliant records
- Participate in interdisciplinary care team meetings
- Provide crisis intervention as needed in collaboration with staff
- Coordinate with courts and external providers when needed
