

# From the Stewardship Committee STEWARDS OF THE GIFTS OF GOD'S GRACE (part 4)

What's the difference between a talent and a spiritual gift? In our exploration of spiritual gifts some may be wondering if talents we may have been born with or learned and developed is the same as a spiritual gift. Jeff from Spiritual Gifts Project.org helps to clarify the difference between a talent and a spiritual gift. Here is what he writes: "While there may be some overlap between spiritual gifts and talents, there are some key differences between the two. A talent is a natural ability or skill that a person has, often in a particular area such as music, art, athletics, or academics. Talents are usually developed through practice and training, and they can be used for a variety of purposes, including personal fulfillment, career success, and service to others. On the other hand, a spiritual gift is a special ability or talent that is given to a believer by the Holy Spirit for the purpose of building up the church and advancing the kingdom of God. Spiritual gifts are described in the New Testament and include gifts such as prophecy, teaching, healing, administration, and many others. While talents can be used for the benefit of others and for the glory of God, they are not necessarily the same as spiritual gifts. Spiritual gifts are specifically given by the Holy Spirit for the purpose of building up the church, and they are usually associated with specific roles or ministries within the church. Additionally, while talents can be developed through natural means such as practice and training, spiritual gifts are given solely by the Holy Spirit and cannot be developed or earned by human effort. Overall, while there may be some overlap between talents and spiritual gifts, they are distinct categories with different origins, purposes, and applications."

# <u>September Mission Project -</u> St. Claire School, Jacmel, Haiti

The people of Haiti continue to persevere despite the political instability, natural disaster, and poverty that grips their country. The World Bank reports the Haitian economy contracted for four consecutive years by 1.7% in 2019, 3.3% in 2020, 1.8% in 2021, and 1.7% in 2022. A child born today in Haiti will grow up to be only 45% as productive as they could be if he or she had enjoyed full access to quality education and healthcare. Families in Haiti lack the benefit of work, education, and healthcare that most of us take for granted.

The St. Claire School supported by The Reverend Jean M. Parisot Foundation in Jacmel, Haiti is a haven for over 100 children from kindergarten through eighth grade. Since public education is not a reality in Haiti, fami-

lies must pay to send their children to school. The St. Claire School does not charge tuition. The generosity of their donors allows the students the opportunity for education and food daily during the school year at no cost to their families.

The St. Claire School employs local teachers and administrators who are familiar with the people and culture of Jacmel. The Parisot Foundation's mission is to support Jacmel through education of the children and opportunity for the community. All building maintenance / repairs are completed by workers within the city. It is important to the Foundation that independence is part of the school's curriculum.
