New Hope's Mission and Vision

As described on their website, "New Hope works throughout <u>South-Central and South-eastern Massachusetts</u> with those affected by domestic and sexual violence. By building an anti-violence movement, we seek to create communities free from violence, where individuals and families are able to achieve their full human potential. As an organization dedicated to social justice, New Hope encompasses a way of seeing, naming, understanding, and acting aimed at addressing inequality and oppression across society. Our vision is a simple one, 'Every person has the right to live a life free of violence and exploitation.'

"New Hope is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization serving those affected by domestic and sexual violence. Since domestic and sexual violence are often intertwined, our clients benefit from the full spectrum of programs we offer, allowing them to receive domestic and sexual violence services in one place. We offer a wide range of services which combine crisis intervention, violence prevention, life transition, and selfsufficiency opportunities, while promoting behavioral and systemic changes to reduce violence at the individual and community levels. In 2016 we completed a 5-year strategic plan that focuses on (1) increasing services to those who have been traditionally underserved, (2) increasing our primary prevention services, and (3) increasing our collaborations to serve more effectively those who are most vulnerable. Praise Report #1 - March & April Mission - 'Ukraine Relief Fund'

We have been appealing for support for refugees and for elderly and other vulnerable people who are displaced within Ukraine and unable to leave. Gifts made to UCC Ukraine Relief Fund provides shelter. food, and other care to war refugees and internally displaced people. From March 1st through April 3rd, we received and already sent to the UCC Ukraine Relief Fund \$1,691.00. From the weeks of April 10th through April 24th an additional amount of \$1.721.00 has been received and a second check will be released to UCC. In total our congregation has provided \$3,412.00 to support the relief effort in Ukraine. Thank-you for your compassionate and generous contributions. As a people of faith, may we individually and corporately continue to unite in prayer for the people of Ukraine. Ask God to continue calling and sending volunteers equipped to provide spiritual and emotional care plus practical support in love and compassion to the Ukrainian people and that peace will soon be restored.

Praise Report: #2 - Project Bread – Walk for Hunger – Sunday, May 1st

Our friend and Church members Bill Bentley completed on Sunday, May 1st the twenty - six mile Walk for Hunger sponsored by Project Bread. Bill raised \$2,788 through donor support. This was Bill's 18th year of participation! Since the actual walk did not take place in Boston, as in 2020 and 2021 due to COVID, Bill did his twentysix mile walk in North Attleboro starting at 6:00 AM and finishing at 1:00 PM. God answered our prayers for Bill's safety and strength throughout the walk and it was a warm, sunny day! Best weather day in several weeks!!!
