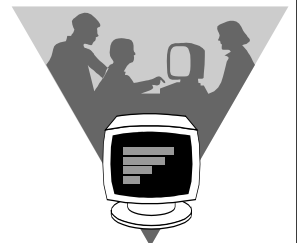
LAND LINE USERS; If you want to call from a land line, Just dial; 1-646-876-9923.

You should then hear a Zoom recording asking you to enter your meeting ID (which I know you wrote down) It is; 214 819 8082 # (no spaces and yes, you have to push the pound sign at the end). It may then advise you to dial *6 to mute your line. Go ahead and do that. We can unmute you once you're on but it gets very noisy if this is not done

Be patient... it dials the number, which is answered by a recording asking you to enter the meeting ID. The commas in the number are 10 second pauses after which the meeting ID will automatically be entered including the # symbol and you should be directed to the meeting.

To Help Fight the Spread of COVID-19

- ◆ Wash your hands frequently throughout the day using soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds (two rounds of singing Happy Birthday).
- ◆ Sneeze or cough into the crook of your elbow or a tissue, not your

hand. Wash your hands immediately after coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose.

- ◆ Avoid touching your face, especially your mouth, nose and eyes, with unwashed hands.
- ◆ Regularly disinfect surfaces frequently touched including keyboards, door knobs, light switches, TV remotes, phones and countertops.
- ◆ Use Hand Sanitizer when soap and water are not readily available.
- ◆ Avoid close contact with someone who is sick.
- ◆ Keep a minimum of 6ft away from others when out in public such as at the grocery store or picking up medications.
- ◆ STAY HOME if you are sick, even if you are unsure as to whether you have COVID-19.
- ◆ Follow all the guidelines put out by

local and state governments, the World Health Organization and CDC. If you are unable to use a computer, watch the news regularly for updates.

- ◆ Gov. Charlie Baker has mandated we all wear face masks when out in public to help stop the spread of the virus. **Please remember that we must ALL wear a mask when out in public where social distancing (staying 6ft apart) is not possible.**
- ◆ Please remember this is not a time for kids to have play dates or for other group gatherings as would usually take place on weekends and vacations.
- ◆ **Stay home as much as possible** and be well. We pray we can be together in person soon.

Please call first to be sure someone is there to receive your donation. We have given over 50 masks to people in our church family and in our community. We have 2 left. Thank You for sewing masks for our church family and our community!

If you are using a different pattern, by all means continue to do so.

The two purposes of a face covering are:

- a) to prevent droplets from dispersing into the air, and
- b) to keep your hands away from your face. A potential added benefit, is a slight reduction of anxiety among people who need to be out and about.

MATERIALS NEEDED

We are also seeking **100% cotton fabric, stretchy fabric headbands, and 1/4" sewing elastic** so the people sewing can make more masks.
