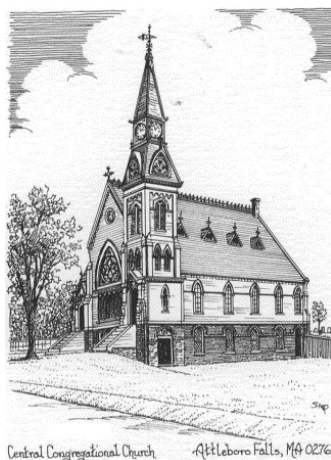

**FRESH SUMMER PRODUCE** If you have a garden at home and wish to donate fresh fruits or veggies to Lenore's Pantry, **PLEASE CALL** Ann Marie Fleming, NA Town Health Nurse, at 508-699-0103 **PRIOR** to bringing the produce to the Pantry (inside the NA Town Hall). **PLEASE NOTE: You must deliver fresh produce directly to the Pantry, yourself.** We **cannot** accept fresh produce here at the church as we do not have the proper storage for it.

**PLEASE ALSO NOTE:** Please be sure to check the **expiration dates** on food you plan to donate. Food Pantries cannot hand out expired foods. If they do, they risk losing their 501c3 status which means they are no longer eligible to buy from the Greater Boston Food Bank where many foods are cents on the dollar. The church must throw expired foods away prior to delivering our donations to the pantry.

**The Kids' Summer Café - Summer Mission 2019**

Many children in our local communities will be facing hunger this summer. Kids receiving free/reduced meals during the school year often suffer malnutrition and do not have enough food during the summertime, seriously impacting their physical and mental health. When school gets out there is a sudden increased need for food in households already experiencing poverty, creating a hunger crisis in the summer for families in our area. The Attleboro Area Interfaith Collaborative's Kids' Summer Café program combats hunger by providing children with a healthy lunch when school is not in session. Free-bagged lunches are distributed three times a week at four local playgrounds in Attleboro & Norton during the summer.
