Pastor's Ponderings

Summer seems to have passed too quickly. Maybe it's because the extended heat waves kept us indoors. Maybe it's because each year, time seems to move faster. Now Fall is upon us. And it is full of its own rhythms of life: leaf color, life piles, apple cider donuts, apple picking, pumpkins, back-to-school, sports, cooler nights....

I preach and pray a lot in worship about the power of the present moment. It is the place where we find God and our most authentic selves. We won't find it in reminiscing or regretting the past. We won't find it in fearing or framing the future. And while the insights of the past are important, and planning for the future has a value, both need to be done from mindfulness of God in the present moment.

Fall will offer us many of these opportunities. Each season does. Each day does. Each moment does. I think that is one of the most crucial values of worship. When we gather as the body of Christ something shifts inside us. When we can fully bring ourselves in the present worship moment it realigns us to what is most real. It's the strength we gain from each other in "Our Oasis of Caring and Joy". It's the acknowledgement that we can't do this alone. It's the opportunity to offer praise and gratitude along with our vulnerability and needs.

And whether we fully know each other's stories or not, we know that we are joined in worship by a group of people struggling and savoring in life, just like us. That seems most real to me as I read our long list of names during the time of prayer. Even if we don't know the story behind each name, we know our own stories and the many stories we have encountered and we lift up each other in trust.

May this Fall season and each new season bring your heart home to the healing of God's community of faith.

Updates & Outcomes

June & July Mission - KIDS' SUMMER CAFÉ

The Kids' Summer Café, coordinated by the Attleboro Area Interfaith Collaborative (AAIC), provided nutritious lunches for children of school age up to eighteen. These meals were available on weekdays at four park locations from June 30 to August 15, offering an alternative to the free or reduced-price lunch program during the school year. A donation of \$1,173.00 was made through contributions and mission funds to support food purchases. Thank you for your contributions. Pray for the children as they return to school.

Our International Sponsorship Programs for Children

<u>Tibetan Refugee Self Help Center, Darjeeling,</u> India

The new child we are sponsoring through UCC Global Ministries Child & Elder Sponsorship Program is TENZIN YANGZOM. She is 8 years of age. Her father runs a small street restaurant where he is the sole breadwinner of her family as her mother is a homemaker. Tenzin is studying in Class II. She loves singing and dancing and spending time drawing. Look for Tenzin's picture on the mission bulletin board in the Vestry.

More than 650 Tibetans live in a cohesive and productive community at the Self-Help Center. This rehabilitation organization trains adults in handicraft arts to support their families while children are provided <u>free</u> education, in both Hindu and English, and textbooks and school supplies. <u>Please pray for Tenzin</u>, her family and all of the families and children at the center.

• <u>The Reverend Jean Parisot Foundation - St. Claire</u> <u>School, Jacmel, Haiti</u>

The sole focus of the Reverend Jean M. Parisot Foundation in Jacmel, Haiti is the operation of a recently built liberal arts and vocational school and dormitories for one hundred impoverished youth. Currently the Foundation is running a grammar school for 125 children in preschool through eighth grade. Every child receives a nutritious meal in addition to a free education. Please pray for the school, its leadership, teachers, and students! Please feel free, anytime throughout the year, to send a donation for the school. Make your check payable to Central Congregational Church and add "Haiti School" in the memo line. Thanks for supporting and praying for the children of Haiti.

Year-Round Missions
