- a. Fuel Breaks New & Existing (Bonnie)
 - Brush clearing along the fire department access roads on Alpine Blvd from W. Willows to E. Willows. County permit is needed to do this work. (FB2024-002)
 - ii. Awarded SPFMG CPG 2024 GRANT to move forward with proposed price from SLO-Mow to brush 50' off both sides of the fire access road on Bullard Lane (West Side) of fire district. This road serves as access road for Type 3 engines on brush response lakeside, San Miguel and County Fire agencies.
