
Please remember during yard cleanup:



Did you know that September is Emergency Preparedness Month? Preparedness starts close to home. To adequately prepare for future disasters, follow these four steps:

- 1. Know Your Risk What are your local risks and how may they impact you and your family? Flooding? Wind? Severe weather? Knowing how you may be impacted will help you identify how you need to prepare.
- 2. Make A Plan Planning ahead will help family members reduce stress and save time and money. Communication is key. Make sure everyone in your family understands what to do when an emergency arises.
- 3. Build An Emergency Supply Kit Prepare to be self-sufficient for three days. Have enough supplies to include visitors and pets.

Have a go-bag for a quick evacuation. Cash, copies of important papers, ID, and medication are key components of your go bag.

4. Get Involved - Be prepared to help within your community. Get to know your local first responders, take a CPR class, learn basic first aid. Taking these actions will make you feel more confident to help yourself and others should the need arise.


