Ad-Hoc Pet Rules Committee Report – 10/17/2024

The committee met on Friday, October 11, 2024. There was a total of 16 attendees at the meeting. There were 10 committee members, the committee secretary and 5 observers.

The committee agreed to have Lori Gutierrez as the secretary; determined three more meeting dates (October 25, November 1 & November 15) and agreed to the Committee Definition.

Committee Definition:

The Ad-Hoc Pet Rules Committee – a temporary committee put in place to review Declaration of Restrictions & Easements (DRE), By-Laws and Restrictions / Rules / Regulations (RRR) specific to pet rules. The committee will advise the Board of Directors with suggested changes to consider. The committee will be disbanded upon completion of the intended goal.

All attendees were provided with folders that included the current Declaration of Restrictions and Easements (DRE), By-Laws & Restrictions / Rules / Regulations (RRR).

Additional documents provided included: Robert's Rules Quick Reference, WJV Voting Requirements, Sample Ballots from WJV, Sample Pet Regulations, Horry County Laws and South Carolina Laws.

The committee defined agenda topics for the future meetings.

Our next meeting will focus on the current RRR, and the Declaration of Restrictions and Easements Pet Rules found in #6.
