PINEAPPLE CASSEROLE

- 120 oz can chunk pincapple (save juice)
- ½ cup juice
- 1 cup cheese (sharp)
- ½ cup Augar
- 3 tbsp. flour
- 12-15 Ritz crackers, crushed
- 1/4 cup melted margarine

Grease a casserole dish. Drain pineapple saving 1/4 cup juice. Grate I cup cheese and sprinkle over pineapple in dish. Wix 1/2 cup sugar, flour, juice, and 3 tablespoons melted margarine. Pour over pineapple and cheese in dish. Crush crackers and pour 1/4 cup melted margarine. Stir well. Place on contents of dish. Bake at 350° for 30 minutes or until it bubbles.
