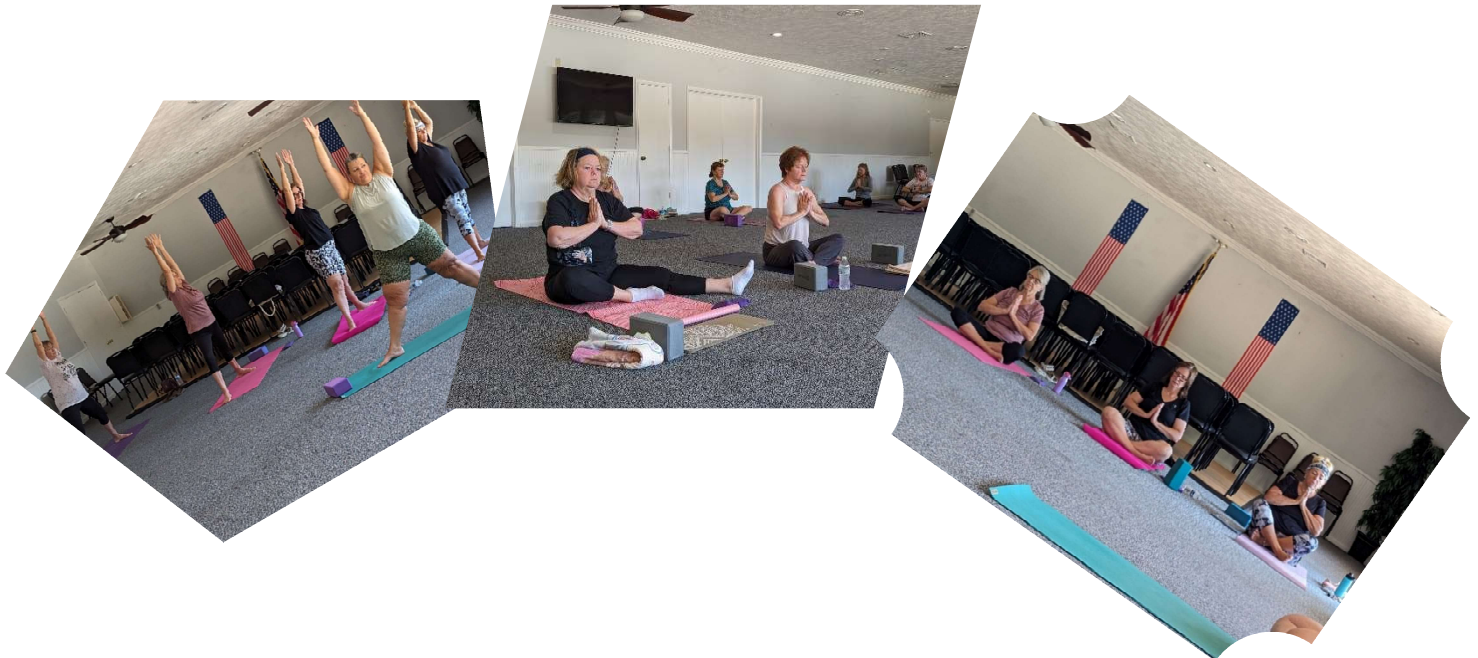

They received a \$50 gift certificate to Cooper's Tavern.



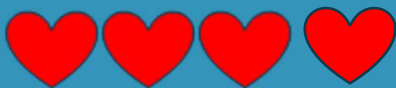

Wed (CLOSED)

Highway 9 Waste Plant

Take HWY 9 approximately 8.7 miles, on left. **Hours are:**

Sun (1pm-7pm)
Mon, Wed, Thurs, Fri and Sat (7am-7pm)
