The Twelves Days of Holiday Fire Safety

Season's Greetings from your friends on the WJV Safety Committee! We hope that you'll be fire safe as you honor the holidays this year!

Follow these recommended safety tips:

Day 1 – Holiday Lighting – If you leave home or go to bed, turn off holiday lighting until you return, or until it can be attended once again.

Day 2 – Chimneys & Vents – For wood burning chimneys, fireplaces, and vents, have a qualified professional clean and inspect them before use this season.

Day 3 – Water That Tree! – Live trees and additional greenery need to be watered daily.

Day 4 – Outside Decorations – Decorations should be specified for outdoor use. Avoid cords running through and/or getting pinched by windows or doors.

Day 5 – Light Strands – Test your strands before use and read manufacturer's instructions on the number of strands to connect together.

Day 6 – Keep Exits Unblocked – Ensure trees and other decorations do not block any exits such as windows or doors.

Day 7 – Holiday House Guests – Make sure all overnight guests know the sound of your **working** smoke alarms and your designated, outside meeting place.

Day 8 – Candle With Care – Use sturdy, non-tipping holders on a flat, non-flammable surface. Use battery-operated, flameless candles when possible.


