A BIG hit at the Luau!

AUTHENTIC HAWAIIAN MACARONI SALAD


Servings: 10 Calories: 563

Ingredients:

- 1 pound macaroni
- 2 tablespoons apple cider vinegar
- 2 carrots (shredded)
- 1/4 cup onion (finely diced)
- 2 ½ cups Dukes mayonnaise
- 1/4 cup milk
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- Kosher salt and pepper, to taste

Instructions:

- 1. Cook macaroni according to package directions. Drain well and place macaroni in a large bowl.
- 2. While macaroni is still hot, sprinkle on vinegar and add carrot and onion. Toss together until well combined. Allow to cool for about 10–15 minutes.
- In a separate, smaller bowl, whisk together mayo, milk and sugar.
- 4. Fold mayo mixture into the macaroni until all the noodles are evenly coated. Add salt and pepper to taste



Cover and refrigerate at least 4 hours (best if overnight). Gently stir before serving adding a little more milk if needed, no more than a tablespoon or two


