At the end of the Gunflint Trail, 54 miles northwest of Grand Marais, MN, is where you will find Wilderness Canoe Base. Wilderness Canoe Base is situated on two islands on Sea Gull Lake. They are focused on nurturing Christ-centered identity through a wilderness experience. In the heart of the forest, and on the lakes and streams of the Boundary Water Canoe Area Wilderness, you will find stillness and serenity.
